

Marham Village Defibrillators.

There are currently four defibrillators within Marham village.

1. Village Hall.

There is a defib situated to the right-hand side of the Village hall main entrance.

This is provided and administered by Marham Parish Council and is always available for public use.

2. Marham Sports and Social Club.

There is a second defib situated on the side of the sports pavilion facing the bowls club.

This defib is provided and administered by Shouldham Football Club but is registered for public use at all times.

3. Donatos Pizzeria.

There is a third defib on the front face of Donatos Pizzeria.

This defib is provided and administered by Donatos Pizzeria for the benefit of the village and is available for public use if called for.

4. RAF Marham

There is a fourth defib just within the outer gates of RAF Marham.

This defib is provided and administered by RAF Marham and is also available for public use if necessary.

In the event of an emergency you should phone 999, if the use of a defibrillator is required the call operator will give you the access code to the nearest cabinet.

- 1. Simply enter the code and open the cabinet to access the defibrillator, please be aware the cabinets are alarmed.**
- 2. They are simple to use and once switched on verbal prompts are given.**
